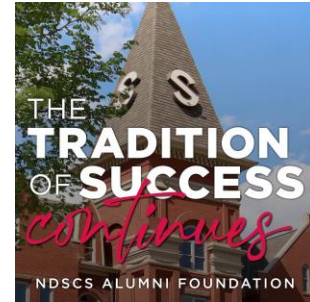


February 10, 2022 | 24 Hour Online Event
