Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, as regular meeting of the Foundation Executive Board of NDSCS, Wahpeton North Dakota, was duly called and held in President Richman's office, on Thursday, October 4th, 2018 at 8:00 AM.

President Bob Gette welcomed everyone and he then asked that the minutes from September 6, 2018 Executive Committee meeting be accepted. Roger Richels made the motion and Chris Johnson seconded the motion. The motion then passed unanimously.
