Challenge Grant Update

In 2015, North Dakota legislators once again created the North Dakota Challenge Fund Matching Grant Program. NDSCS has been allocated up to \$1,000,000 in matching funds to be awarded if we can raise \$2,000,000 in private donations. The guidelines for the program are as follows: Projects must be at least \$25,000 in size and be exclusively dedicated to the advancement of enhanced academics including investments in research, scholarships, technology, endowed chairs and investments in educational infrastructure. To date, we have raised over 1.16 M with matching funds of \$583,000. Of the dollars raised, \$1.64 M has been invested into Endowment Scholarships, which will benefit recruiting new students and retaining current students. We anticipate completing our 2M goal before December of 2016.
