Together we can accomplish great things! The NDSCS Nursing Department was able to purchase a new \$116,000 SimMan 3G manikin with the funds raised from the Giving Hearts Day campaign, a West Central Initiative Grant, DREAMS Auction proceeds and some department funds.

The SimMan 3G is an advanced patient simulator that allows students to experience real life scenarios such as drug reactions, stroke symptoms and seizures. Nursing students are able to practice different interventions and various medical procedures.
